•	Wear comfortable clothes that you can walk and lay on an exam table in. Ladies, please do not wear a one-piece dress.

*	Bring a list of your medications with you	to the test.	i		
*	If you have diabetes and take insulin injections or oral medication, take half your normal dose the morning of the test or check with your doctor who handles your diabetes about your medication dosage on the day of the test. (N/A if Dobutamine)				
•	If you are scheduled for an Adenosine or Lexiscan stress test, please take all of your medications as usual except Aggrenox, persantine (dipyridamole) hold for 48 hours and theophyline hold for 24 hours				
*	If you use inhalers, have asthma or wheezing problems please let the staff know. If you are having a Cardiolite Treadmill or a Dobutamine test and are taking certain medications called beta-blockers or calcium channel blockers, such as Atenolol, Tenormin, Lopressor, verapamil etc. SEE LIST ON BACK. Check with the Doctor who ordered the test and ask if you should stop

*	Do not eat for three (3) hours prior to the early in the morning.	test. If you	ır test is i	in the afternoon you may have a l	ight meal
*	DO NOT have CAFFEINE in any form for 24 hours before any nuclear test. This is especially				
	important if you are scheduled for an Adenosine or Lexiscan test. You must avoid foods, such as				
	chocolate which contain caffeine. Do not drink caffeinated or decaffeinated beverages such as soda's				
	(Coke, Pepsi, Mountain Dew), coffee or tea. No Excedrin or other over the counter medications which				
	contain caffeine. Caffeine inactivates the adenosine/lexiscan and the test will have to be cancelled.				
•	Mid-way through the test you will need to	o eat some	thing. Plea	ase bring a snack.	
4. Allow 3 to	4 hours for this test.				

5. You will have an intravenous (I.V.) line placed so we can inject the isotope before and during the test.

6. Your test results will be reviewed by our cardiologist and reported to your physician. Your physician will discuss the
